The Verb in the Present Indefinite (Simple) Tense

Rule 1. If the verb has endings –s, -o, -x, -sh, -ch		
Pronouns	Verbs	Combinations
I	dress, go, relax, wash, watch	I dress, go, relax, wash, watch
he		He dresses, goes, relaxes, washes, watches
she		She dresses, goes, relaxes, washes, watches
it		It dresses, goes, relaxes, washes, watches
you		You dress, go, relax, wash, watch
we		We dress, go, relax, wash, watch
they		They dress, go, relax, wash, watch

Rule 2. If the verb has endings –y after consonant sound		
Pronouns	Verbs	Combinations
I	study	I study
he		He studies
she		She studies
it		It studies
you		You study
we		We study
they		They study

Rule 3. In other cases		
Pronouns	Verbs	Combinations
I	live, plan, enjoy	I live, plan, enjoy
he		He lives, plans, enjoys
she		She lives, plans, enjoys
it		It lives, plans, enjoys
you		You live, plan, enjoy
we		We live, plan, enjoy
they		They live, plan, enjoy
