<b>you</b>	have spoken		will have spoken
<b>we</b>	have spoken		shall have spoken
<b>they</b>	have spoken		will have spoken

Pronouns	Passive Voice Noun + To have + been + Past Participle		
	Present	Past	Future
<b>I</b>	have been spoken	had been spoken	shall have been spoken
<b>he</b>	has been spoken		will have been spoken
<b>she</b>	has been spoken		will have been spoken
<b>it</b>	has been spoken		will have been spoken
<b>you</b>	have been spoken		will have been spoken
<b>we</b>	have been spoken		shall have been spoken
<b>they</b>	have been spoken		will have been spoken
